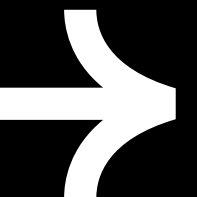
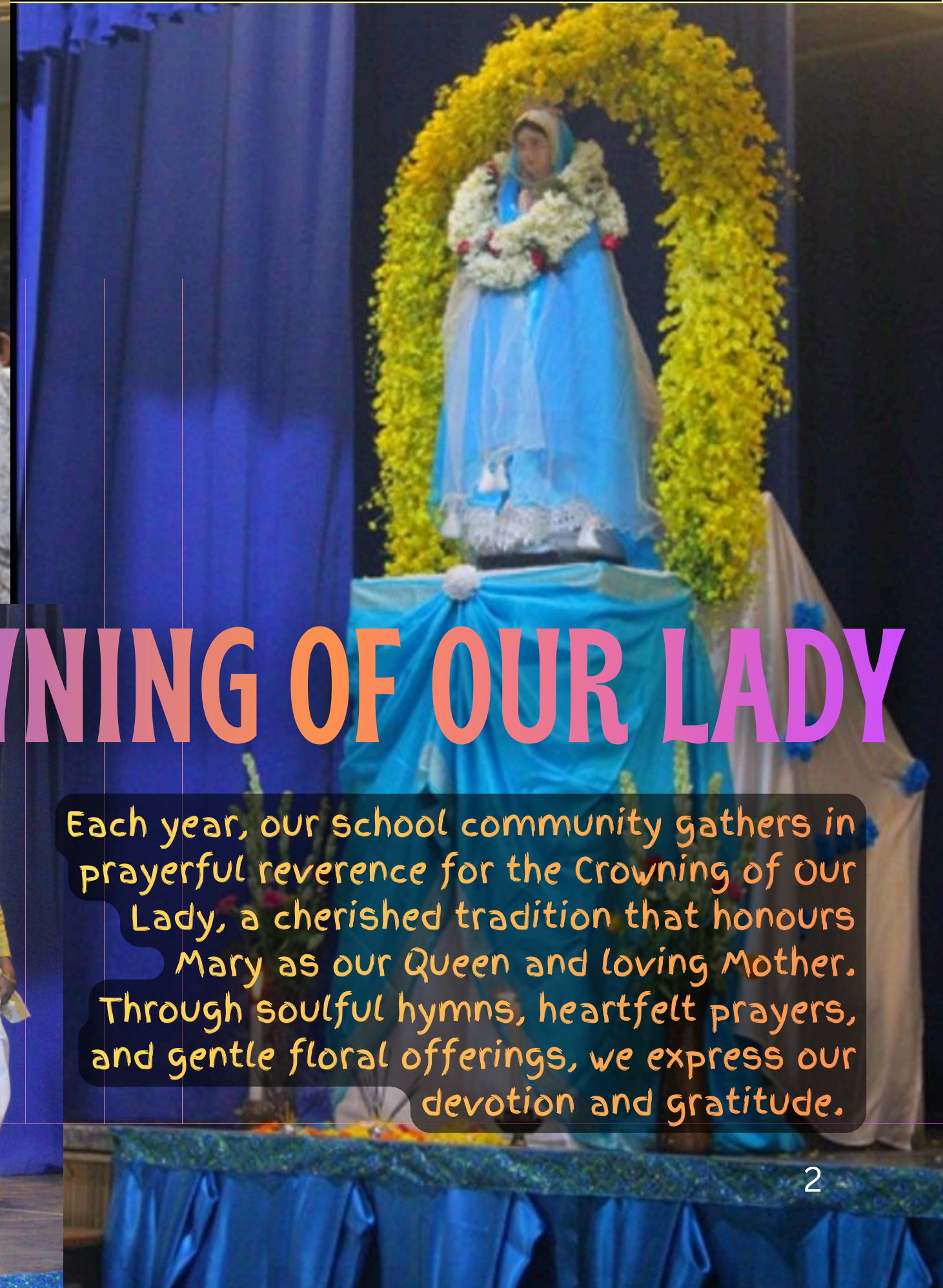

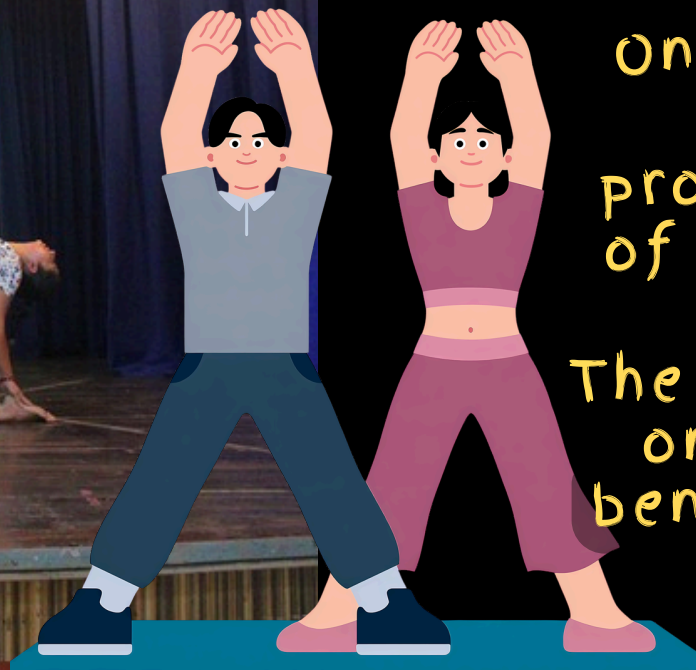


INTERACTIVE SESSION WITH PARENTS

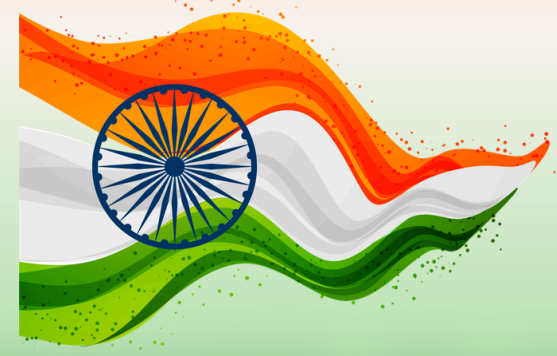

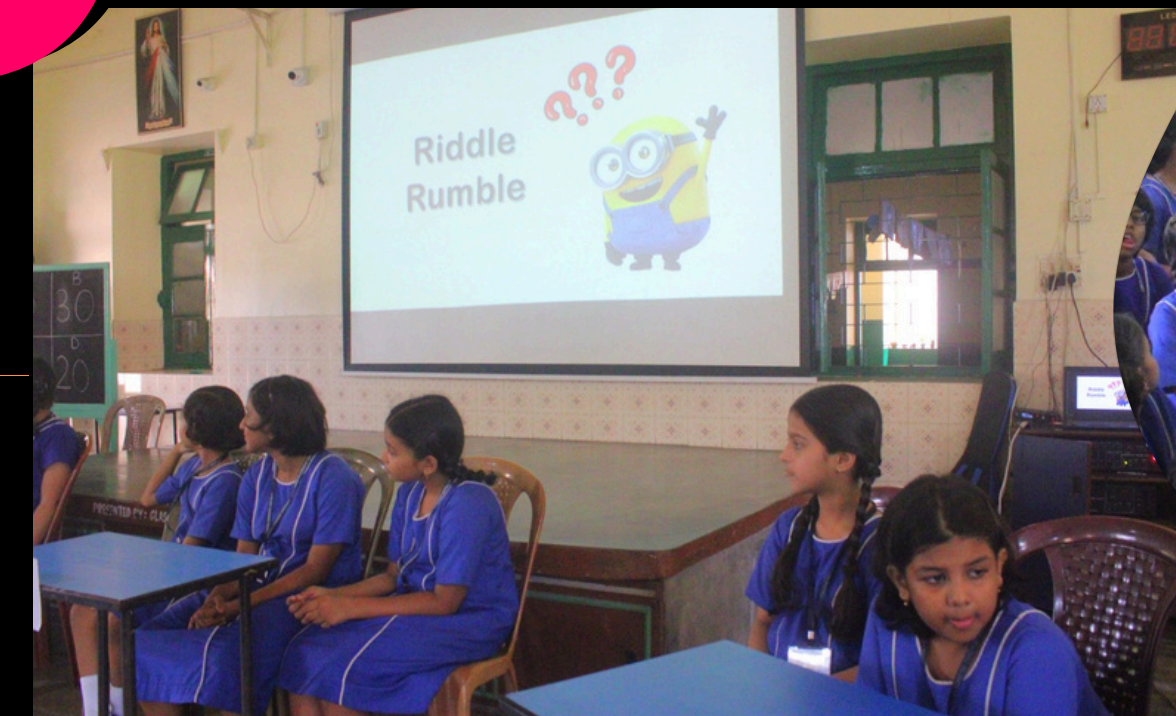


JUNIOR SECTION QUIZ

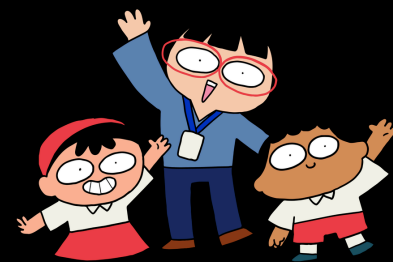


VANIJAYA FEST [commerce department]

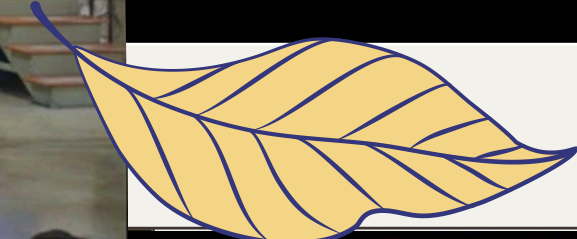
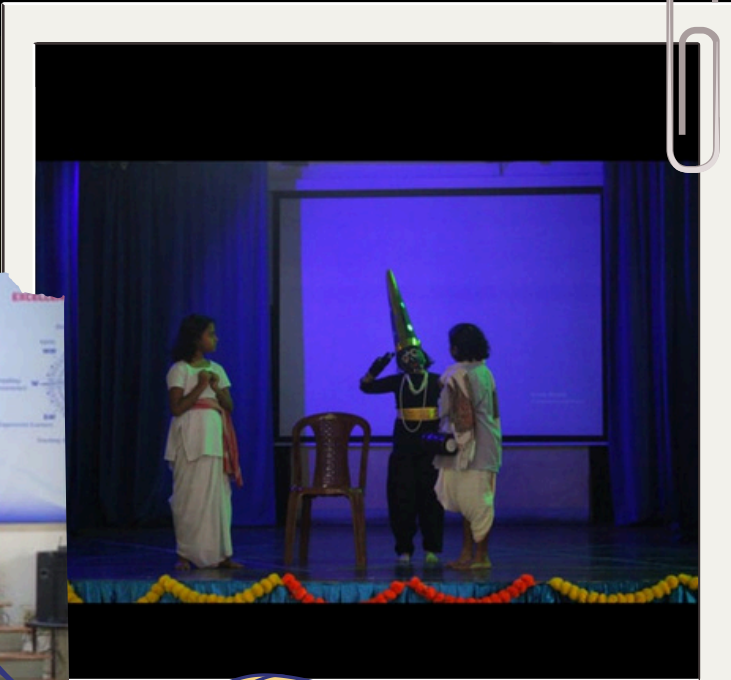

RHYTHMIC RETREAT

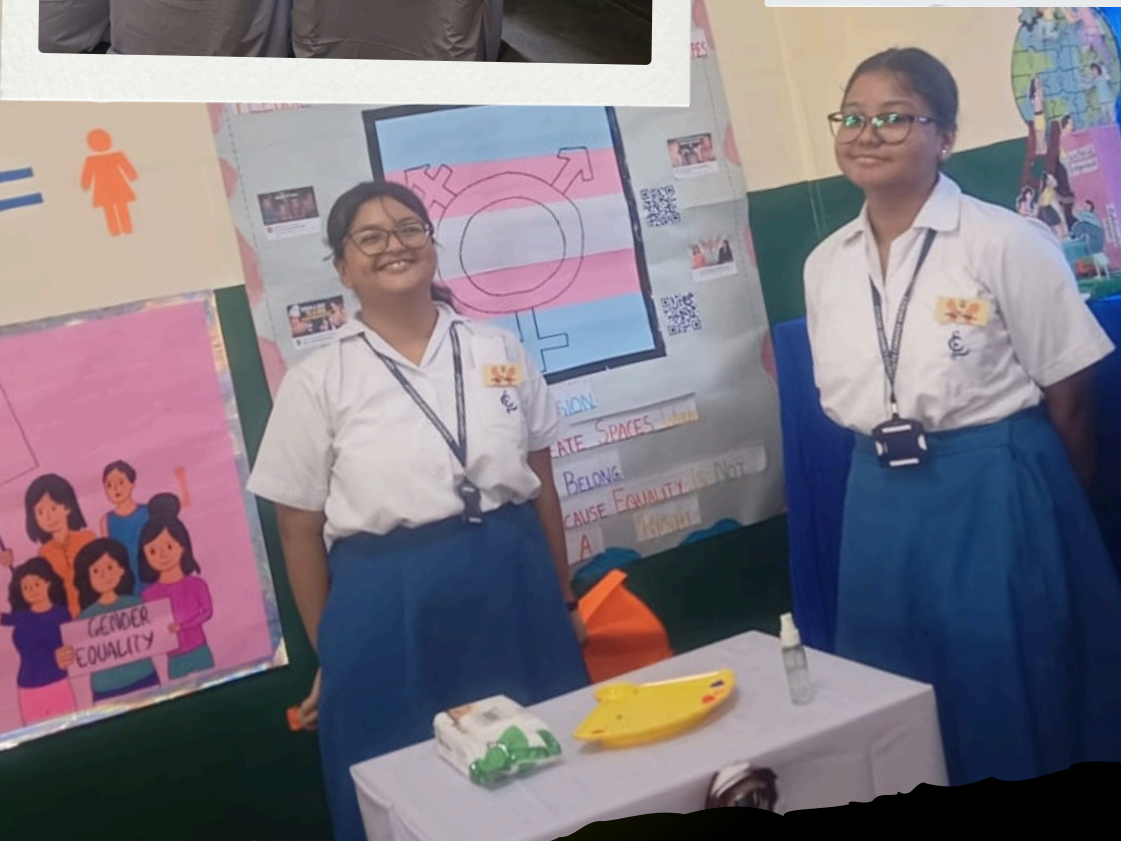
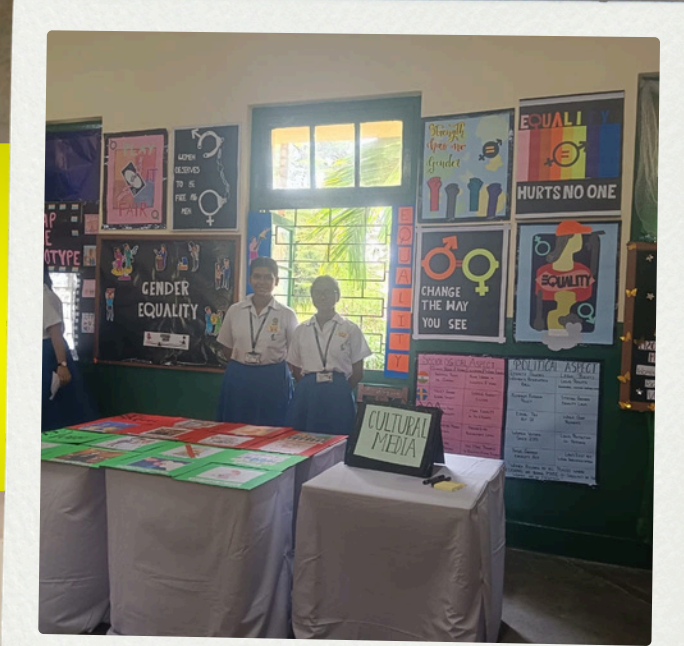

ANNUAL EXHIBITION - VISTAR

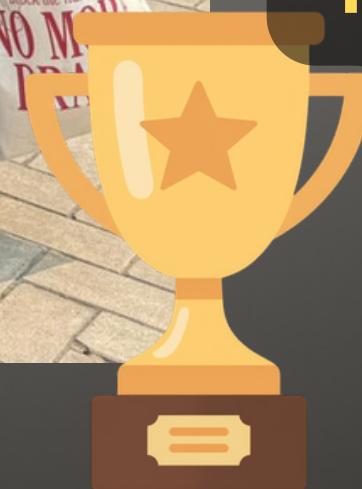

CHRISTMAS SHARING



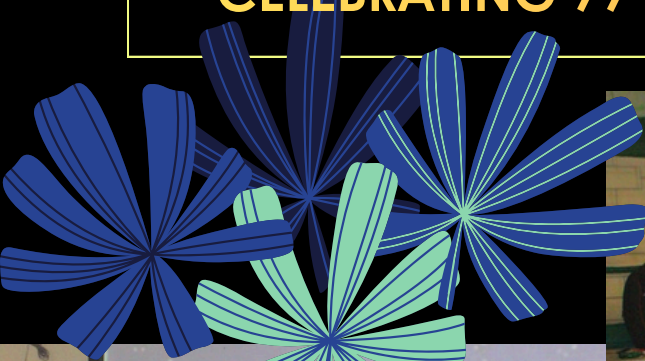

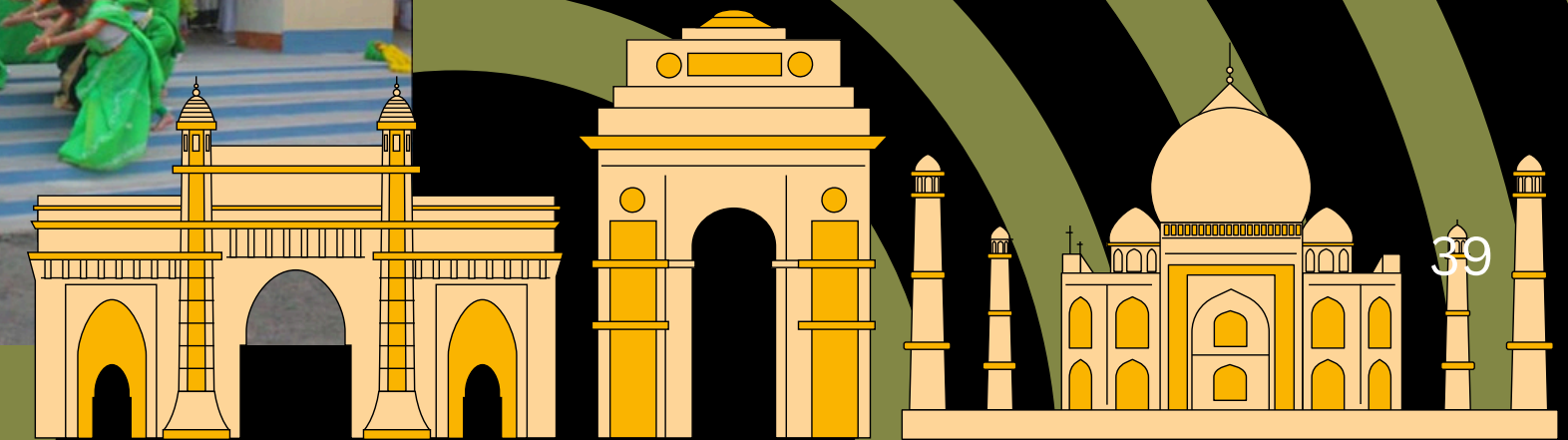
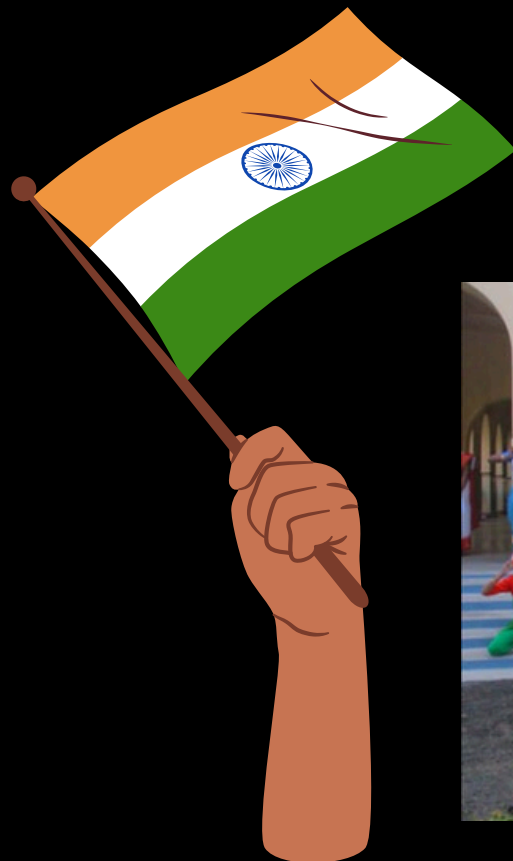
REPUBLIC DAY JUNIOR SECTION

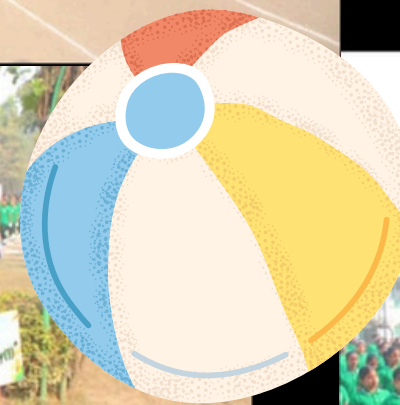

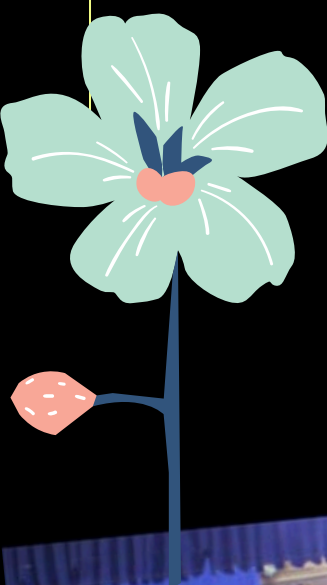


FURRY FRIENDS
