AXIOM-4 MISSION: SHUBHANSHU SHUKLA, THE FIRST INDIAN AT ISS

Group Captain Shubhanshu Shukla of the Indian Air Force created history on Thursday (June 26, 2025) by becoming the first Indian to enter the International Space Station. As the Dragon crew capsule carrying Group Captain Shukla and three other astronauts as part of Axiom Mission 4 (Ax-4) orbited Earth, he greeted people back home with a "Namaste" from space. The spacecraft docked with the ISS at 4:01 p.m. IST. He shall stay at ISS for 14 days.

This trip to space is not only iconic for India but it also aims to help Indian Space Organisation to lead certain scientific experiments that include research on crop viability in microgravity to biological resilience in extreme environments.



CBSE Class 10 Students to Get Option of Two Board Exams
In a bid to reduce the stress of critical board exams, Class 10 students will be given the option of taking their exams twice from 2026 onwards, the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) said on Wednesday (June 26, 2025). This option to improve performance in up to three academic subjects will only be provided to students who pass the first examination, officials said. "The policy will be implemented for students studying in academic year 2025-26, who will sit for their board exams in 2026," said Dr. Sanjay Barik, Controller of Exams, CBSE.

Neeraj Chopra Reclaims World Number 1 Rank in Javelin Throw

Neeraj Chopra began the year with a win at the Potch Invitational in Potchefstroom, South Africa, in April and followed it up with a second-place finish at the Doha Diamond League in May, where he recorded a new national record of 80.23m.

Nine months after he'd relinquished the spot, Neeraj Chopra reclaimed the world number 1 rank in men's javelin throw, according to the latest World Athletics ranking update. The reigning world champion climbed to the top of the ladder with 1445 ranking points, ahead of Grenada's Anderson Peters, who is second with 1403 points.



England stun India with Five-wicket Win in the First Ever Test Match Played for Anderson-Tendulkar Trophy

In Test cricket, England defeated India by five wickets in the opening match of the Anderson-Tendulkar Trophy at Headingley, Leeds. Chasing the target of 278, England reached 373 for five in a tense final day, pulling off one of the greatest run chases in Test history.

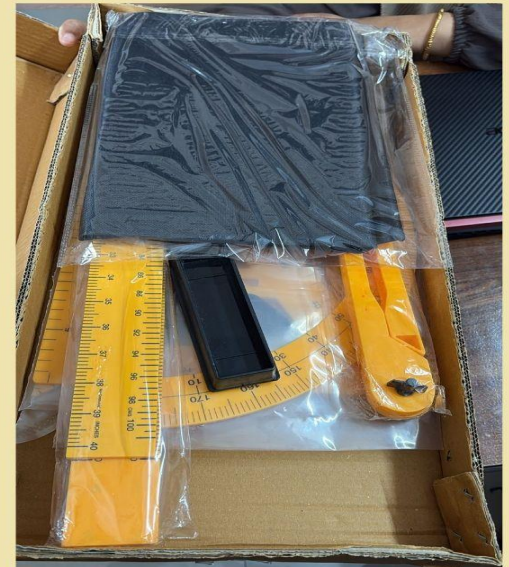
Puri Rath Yatra Starts With Great Pomp and Show: Devotees Surge

The sacred Rath Yatra festival in Puri faced significant delays after a good start, despite the timely completion of rituals, as an unprecedented crowd of devotees—described as 1.5 times larger than anticipated—converged to witness the grand chariot procession of Lord Jagannath, Balabhadra, and Subhadra.

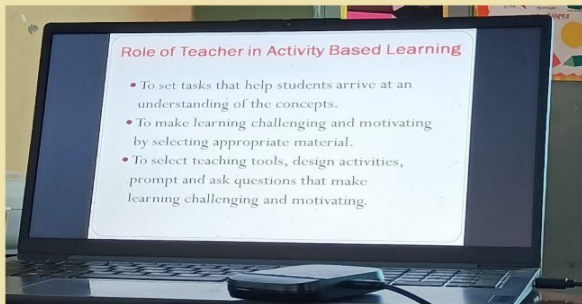

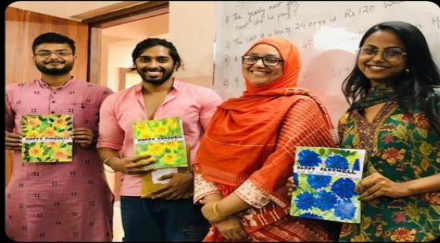
With Teach For India partnership since 2022, the school has tried to grow in every possible way. Community visits, working with children and cooperation throughout, form the true essence of it.

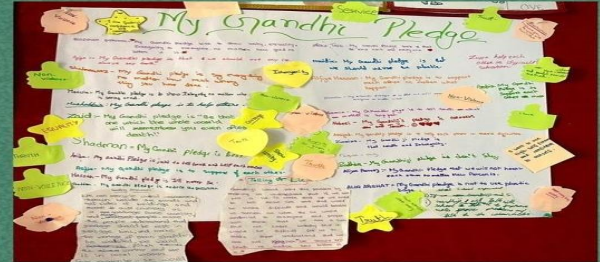
